Climate Change Questionnaire Response — 2025 Reporting Cycle

1. Introduction

This document represents Do Sender Chemicals Co., Ltd.'s annual response to the CDP Climate Change questionnaire. Our disclosure reflects our commitment to climate transparency and alignment with the TCFD recommendations. We achieved a CDP score of B (Management) in the 2025 assessment.

2. Governance

Climate-related responsibilities are overseen by the Board-level ESG Committee, which meets quarterly to review climate risks, opportunities, strategy, and performance metrics. The Chief Operating Officer serves as the management-level climate champion, reporting to the ESG Committee on a bi-monthly basis.

Executive compensation includes ESG performance metrics, with climate-related KPIs (GHG reduction, energy efficiency) accounting for 15% of the annual bonus calculation.

3. Strategy

We have identified and assessed climate-related risks and opportunities using scenario analysis aligned with the IEA Stated Policies Scenario (STEPS) and Net Zero Emissions by 2050 Scenario (NZE). Key transition risks include carbon pricing mechanisms, changing customer preferences for low-carbon products, and regulatory pressure on chemical sector emissions.

Physical risks include increased frequency of extreme weather events affecting our Zibo facility, potential water stress in the Shandong region, and supply chain disruptions from climate-related natural disasters.

Our climate strategy focuses on four pillars: energy efficiency and process optimization, renewable energy procurement, low-carbon product innovation, and supply chain engagement.

4. Risk Management

Climate risk identification and assessment is integrated into our enterprise risk management framework. Risks are assessed based on likelihood, magnitude, and timeframe, with mitigation actions assigned to responsible business functions. We conduct annual climate risk reviews and update our risk register accordingly.

5. Metrics & Targets

Scope 1 Emissions: 4,210 tCO₂e (2025)

Scope 2 Emissions (market-based): 4,240 tCO₂e (2025)

Scope 3 Emissions: 28,500 tCO₂e (2025, estimated)

GHG Reduction Target: 25% reduction in Scope 1+2 emissions intensity by 2030 from a 2023 baseline.

Renewable Energy Target: 50% renewable electricity by 2030 (22% achieved in 2025).

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
