

Modern Slavery Statement

Annual Statement — 2025

Introduction

This statement is made pursuant to applicable modern slavery legislation and sets out the steps taken by Do Sender Chemicals Co., Ltd. during the financial year 2025 to prevent modern slavery and human trafficking in our operations and supply chain.

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in any part of our business or supply chain. We have zero tolerance for such practices.

Our Business & Supply Chain

Do Sender Chemicals manufactures and supplies specialty chemicals including organic peroxides, AZO initiators, metal alkyls, and polymer agents. Our supply chain includes raw material suppliers (primarily chemical intermediates and solvents), packaging suppliers, logistics providers, and equipment manufacturers, predominantly within China.

We assess our supply chain as low-to-medium risk for modern slavery, given our direct engagement with suppliers and the industrial nature of our operations.

Our Actions in 2025

1. Policy Review: Updated our Human Rights Policy and Supplier Code of Conduct to explicitly address modern slavery and human trafficking.
2. Supplier Engagement: Communicated our modern slavery expectations to all key suppliers and required confirmation of compliance.
3. Due Diligence: Incorporated modern slavery risk assessment into our third-party due diligence process.
4. Training: Delivered awareness training on modern slavery to procurement and supply chain teams (25 employees).

5. Grievance Mechanism: Our whistleblower hotline is available for reporting concerns related to modern slavery.

Future Actions

In 2026, we plan to: expand training to a wider group of employees, conduct targeted audits of higher-risk suppliers, and further integrate modern slavery risk assessment into procurement processes.
